COLONEL REBECCA S. CORBIN

Col. Rebecca Corbin is the Deputy Commander, 11th Wing and Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling, Washington D.C. As the Deputy Commander, she assists the Wing Commander in managing global operations for the U.S. Air Force Honor Guard, U.S. Air Force Band, and Arlington National Cemetery Chaplaincy missions. In addition, she enables the 11th Wing's support to Joint Task Force- National Capital Region (NCR), and approximately 70 mission partners through security, personnel management, logistics, contracting, and financial oversight for 18,000 military and civilian employees and their families across the NCR. She teams with Joint Base mission partners such as the Defense Intelligence Agency, Marine Helicopter Squadron One, the White House Communications Agency, the Joint Air Defense Operations Center, the U.S. Coast Guard Station Washington, and the U.S. Navy Ceremonial Guard to sustain a 1,000-acre hub of readiness and support excellence.



A 2003 graduate of Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps, Detachment 535, Syracuse University; Col. Corbin has an undergraduate degree in Civil Engineering. She has also earned a master's degree in engineering management from the Air Force Institute of Technology. She is a graduate of Air Command and Staff College and Air War College. Finally, she holds professional certification as a Project Management Professional (PMP) since 2013.

Her experience in the Civil Engineering career field includes assignments such as SABER section OIC, Emergency Management Flight Commander, Chief of Engineering Operations, Commander of the 611th Civil Engineer Squadron and Commander, 635th Materiel Maintenance Squadron, Holloman AFB New Mexico. Col. Corbin spent two years overseas at Seventh Air Force in Osan Korea and deployed multiple times in support of Operation IRAQI FREEDOM, Operation NEW DAWN, and Operation ENDURING FREEDOM. Her team led beddown efforts in Operation ALLIES WELCOME alongside Task Force Holloman. She also served as Deputy Commander, 635th Materiel Maintenance Group, Holloman AFB, New Mexico. Prior to this assignment Colonel Corbin was the Deputy Commander of the Thomas N. Barnes Center for Enlisted Education, and Director of Operations for Air University, Maxwell AFB, Alabama overseeing the execution of professional military education and warfighter development across the Air Force.
