SUBJECT: REAL ID Base Policy Memorandum

- 1. In accordance with the REAL ID Act of 2005, and DoDM-5200.08, Volume 3, AFMAN 31-101, Volume 3, *Installation Perimeter Access Control*, effective 7 May 2025, all entrants to Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling must present REAL ID-compliant identification to establish identity for unescorted access to the installation.
- 2. Those who wish to gain unescorted access via a DBIDS pass must present an acceptable credential for establishing identity and be screened to establish purpose and fitness for entering the installation. Acceptable credentials and source identity documents must:
 - a. Be original and current (unexpired)
- b. Not contain the markings "Not Valid for Federal Purposes," "Not For Use as Federal Identification," "Federal Limits May Apply," or any other similar phrase
- c. In the case of a driver's license or non-driver's identification card issued by a State, territory, possession, or the District of Columbia, be compliant with the REAL ID Act of 2005
- 3. Individuals who: (1) have an existing DBIDS credential and will require base access after that credential expires, and (2) do not possess REAL ID-compliant identification at the time of renewal, may acquire a one-time, temporary 30-day pass from the Joint Visitor Center. After the 30-day period ends, a REAL ID-compliant identification will be required to continue base access.
- 4. Guests attending special events who have been sponsored by an individual with escort authority and placed on the Base Access List, but who lack REAL ID-compliant identification, must undergo a criminal background check at the installation access control point before being permitted to access the base.
- 5. Escorted access may be provided by those with escort authority to co-travelers who are in possession of current state or federally issued photo identification and are not foreign nationals. Per DoDM-5200.08, Volume 3, AFMAN 31-101, Volume 3, "with the exception of on-duty AFOSI (or sister-service equivalents), FBI, and USSS agents, no one is authorized to escort foreign nationals onto an installation".

- 6. For TMO-procured household goods moves onto or off the installation, sponsors may escort movers who do not possess a REAL ID-compliant identification without having to co-travel, provided movers are not foreign nationals and do not meet any base access disqualifications.
- 7. Personnel with escort authority may vouch for co-travelers under the age of 18 that do not possess a valid photo ID card.
