SUBJECT: 11th Wing Installation Environmental Commitment Statement

- 1. The mission of the 11th Wing is to deliver premier ceremonial honors, contingency operations, and customer service to the Nation's Capital and worldwide, and provide national security and support for Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling's (JBAB) 68 mission partner agencies, its 17,000 military and civilian employees and their families, and over 4,000 on-base residents.
- 2. The 11th Wing is committed to improving environmental performance and management practices across the installation by ensuring environmental compliance and minimizing pollution and waste. The collective mission success of the 11th Wing and its partners depends on our protection of the land, air, and riparian environments.
- 3. JBAB, as an installation, is equally committed to complying with Federal and local environmental regulations to preserve our environment without compromising the mission. We will communicate our environmental commitments and performance to all levels of our organization and the local community. We remain committed to working with district environmental agencies to:
 - a) Promote restoration of the Anacostia and Potomac Rivers through partnerships and adherence. to storm water regulations and permits.
 - b) Reduce and control air emissions.
 - c) Protect cultural and natural resources.
 - d) Adapt to and mitigate climate change and sea level rise.
- 4. We will establish and maintain a Cross Functional Team comprised of leadership and Unit Environmental Coordinators to monitor progress in achieving our goals and objectives. The Scope of the Environmental Management System (EMS) includes all units on JBAB that have operations that could potentially impact the environment and do not fall under a separate EMS. Adherence to these commitments and the continual improvement of our EMS support is a core mission.
